Proposal Submission Information:

Proposal submissions for educational sessions must contain the following:

1. Title
2. Course Description
3. Course Objectives
4. Length of Course
5. Recommended Participant Level
6. Target Audience (PTs, PTAs, Student PTs, Student PTAs, Other Disciplines)
7. Maximum Number of Participants for Lab-Based Sessions
 - The Maximum Number of Participants for Lecture Sessions Will Be Dependent Upon Room Size
8. Speaker Information – Include for All Speakers
 - Name
 - Credentials
 - Institution
 - City/State
 - E-Mail
9. Brief Bio (150 words or less) for Each Speaker
10. Head Shot for Each Speaker

Important Things to Remember When Submitting Your Proposal:

1. If your proposal is selected, speaker information will appear exactly as submitted in all publications, both in print and online. Please ensure the accuracy of this information before finalizing your submission.
2. Indicate how many hours your educational session is, and if there will be a lab.
3. If your session requires space other than the traditional classroom setting, please include this information in your proposal.
4. The APTA New Mexico Education Committee will review all proposals submitted by the deadline. Selection of proposals will be based on the foundation in evidence, clarity of proposal, probable interest to participants, fiscal feasibility, and space and time constraints.
5. Proposals should reflect cultural and/or ethical components related to clinical practice and research as related to session content.
6. Proposals should be devoid of any promotional content.
7. Honorarium is offered at \$100 per contact hour for one speaker or shared amongst multiple speakers.
8. Mileage Reimbursement (at the current IRS approved rate) is offered to accepted speakers traveling from outside of Albuquerque.
